FIFTH SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

The applicants herein, by written request received November 27, 1936, seek a further extension of the effective date of Decision No. 28587 for a period of sixty (60) days from November 30, 1936, for the reason that the order of the Interstate Commerce Commission, Burcau of Motor Carriers, in connection with their application to register with said Commission as a common carrier to engage in the transportation of passenger and property in interstate commerce, has been stayed to a date beyond the effective date of the decision referred to herein.

The relief herein sought appears necessary in order that applicants may consummate their merger as to interstate and intrastate operators concurrently.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the effective date of Decision No. 28397 be and it is hereby extended from November 30, 1936 to and including January 30, 1937.

In all other respects Decision No. 28387 shall remain unchanged and in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
