SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

The County of Orange on December 1, 1936 requested permission to maintain the temporary grade separation under the tracks of Pacific Electric Railway Company in the vicinity of Newport Beach (Crossing No. 6E-35.60-B) authority for which was heretofore granted in this proceeding in Decision No. 27096, dated May 28, 1934. Said temporary crossing was authorized for a period of one year and the authority subsequently extended to December 1, 1936. Said crossing being necessary until the completion of a new crossing in the City of Newport Beach, therefore,

authorized to continue to maintain a crossing of a public road at separated grades, with impaired clearences, under the Newport Beach Line of the Pacific Electric Railway Company, identified as Crossing No. 6E-35.60-B, to and including June 1, 1937; provided, however, that within thirty (30) days from the date of this Order, applicant shall file evidence of consent of Pacific Electric Railway Company to said extension of time.

Applicant shall continue to maintain the protective devices described in Condition (5) of Decision No. 27096 and shall, at its sple expense, on or before June 1, 1937, close and barricade to public use and travel the above identified crossing.

The effective date of this Order shall be the date hereof.
