OPINION AND ORDER

In this application, The Nevada-California Electric Corporation asks this Commission to make its order and decision authorizing applicant to adopt, enforce and collect each and all of the rates, tolls, rentals, charges, classifications, rules, regulations, contracts and schedules which were at 12 P.M. November 30, 1936, in effect on the system of The Southern Sierras Power Company.

In its Decision No. 28616, dated March 9, 1936, on Application No. 20349 and Supplemental Decisions Nos. 28646, 28949 and 29203 dated respectively March 16, 1936, March 29, 1936 and December 19, 1936, this Commission authorized applicant to, and it did, at 12:01 A.M. December 1, 1936, succeed to and take over all of the properties, rights, assets, franchises and business of The Southern Sierras Power Company in the State of California.

It is the opinion of the Commission that this application should be granted and that public hearing in the matter

is not necessary, and good cause appearing therefor,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that The Nevada-California Electric Corporation be and it is hereby authorized to adopt, enforce and collect retroactively to December 1, 1936, each and all of the rates, tolls, rentals, charges, classifications, rules, regulations, contracts and schedules which were at 12 P.M. November 30, 1936, in effect on the system of The Southern Sierras Power Company, and to file with the Commission an adoption sheet covering same.

The effective date of this Order is the date hereof.
