FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Appendix "A" of Decision No. 29342 in the above entitled proceedings be and it is hereby amended by adding the following rule under the sub-heading "Rules and Regulations" on page 1 of the mimeographed copy of said appendix:

"MINIMUM CHARGE: The minimum charge in connection with the rates named in this appendix shall be 35 cents per shipment for shipments weighing 25 pounds or less, and 50 cents per shipment for shipments weighing more than 25 pounds."

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that in all other respects Decision No. 29342 of December 7, 1936, in the above entitled proceedings shall remain in full force and effect.
