FIFTH SUPPLEMENTAL  
OPINION AND ORDER

Pacific Motor Trucking Company by supplemental appli-  
cation seeks authority to establish a pickup and delivery service  
of property in the custody of Southern Pacific Company and  
Pacific Motor Transport Company for Southern Pacific Company's  
station at Tipton, California, for the reason that no local  
drayman is available at such station and unless the applicant is  
authorized to furnish such service there will be no means of  
performing a pickup and delivery service at such station as  
provided for in the tariffs of the carriers.

Applicant by virtue of Decision No. 27235 herein, dated  
July 30, 1934, has been heretofore authorized to operate a motor  
truck service between the railroad stations of Southern Pacific  
Company over and along the route designated "Route No. 2 - Tulare  
Area", one of which stations is Tipton for the transportation of  
property which may have been previously consigned for transpor-  
tation over the lines of said Southern Pacific Company.

This appears to be a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary, and

Good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Decision No. 27235 herein, dated July 30, 1934, be and it is hereby amended to authorize Pacific Motor Trucking Company to perform a pickup and delivery service at Tipton, California, for property which may have been previously consigned for transportation over the lines of Southern Pacific Company, provided that no pickup and delivery service may be given in a distance greater than one mile from the Southern Pacific Company's station at Tipton, California.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that said Decision No. 27235 in all other respects shall remain unaltered and in full force and effect.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Decision No. 29336, dated December 7, 1936, be and it is hereby revoked and annulled.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
