Decision No. 29356 BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA INGINA! In the Matter of the Application of COAST COUNTIES GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY, a corporation, for a certificate that public convenience and necessity require the exercise of a Application No. 20765 right, privilege and franchise to sell and distribute gas for heat and power purposes and to sell and distribute electricity for heat and power purposes. BY THE COMMISSION: SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER In its Decision No. 29178 dated October 13, 1936, the Commission ordered as follows: "The Railroad Commission of the State of California Hereby Orders and Declares that public convenience and necessity require and will require the exercise by Coast Counties Gas and Electric Company of the rights and privileges under the franchises granted to it by Ordinances Nos. 119 and 120 of the City of Hollister, County of San Benito as fully set forth and described in Exhibits "B" and "C" attached to and made a part of the application herein. "IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the above certification and authorization are subject to the following conditions and not otherwise: "(1) That Coast Counties Gas and Electric Company shall file with this Commission on or before January 1, 1937 a stipulation, duly executed upon the authority of its Board of Directors, that applicant, its successors or assigns, will never claim before the Railroad Commission, or any other body or court, a value for said franchises in excess of the actual cost thereof. "(2) Upon filing in proper form of the above stipulation, the Commission will issue its supplemental order authorizing the exercise of the rights conferred by the franchises above described." -1Applicant, having now filed the stipulation referred to above, the Railroad Commission of the State of California hereby orders and declares that a certificate of public convenience and necessity be and it is hereby granted to Coast Counties Gas and Electric Company authorizing it to exercise the rights and privileges under the franchises granted to it by Ordinances Nos. 119 and 120 of the City of Hollister.

The effective date of this Order shall be the date hereof.
