ORDER REVOKING CERTIFICATE

ORIGINAL

WHEREAS Walter C. Clifton operating under the name and style of Pino Grande Stage Line acquired a certificate of public convenience and necessity to transport passengers, packages and baggage, as an automotive common carrier, between Placerville and Pino Grande, by Decision No. 19793, dated May 22, 1928, on Application No. 14641, and,

WHEREAS the Commission has received advice in writing from Mr. Clifton under date of December 1, 1936, that he has not operated under said certificate of public convenience and necessity for three or four years, and,

WHEREAS Mr. Clifton also requests a revocation of said certificate of public convenience and necessity.

THEREFORE, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity heretofore issued to Walter C. Clifton, operating under the name and style of Pino Grande Stage Line, be and it is hereby declared to have been abandoned and all tariffs and time schedules therefor be and they hereby are cancelled.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Decision No. 19793
dated May 23, 1928 be and it is hereby revoked and annulled.
