ORDER REVOKING CERTIFICATE

WHEREAS Wm. V. Hogan, operating under the name and style  
of Concord Transit Co., acquired sole ownership of a certificate  
of public convenience and necessity to transport passengers, as an  
automotive common carrier, between Concord and Avon by Decision  
No. 10842, dated August 10, 1922, on Application No. 8133, and

WHEREAS the aforementioned Wm. V. Hogan was also granted  
a certificate of public convenience and necessity to transport  
passengers as an automotive common carrier between Clayton and  
Concord and intermediate points by Decision No. 12781, dated November  
5, 1923, on Application No. 9209, and

WHEREAS the Commission has been advised in writing by Wm. V. Hogan, under date of December 16, 1936, that he has not operated under said certificates of public convenience and necessity or any of them since April, 1935, for lack of patronage,

THEREFORE, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the certificates of public convenience and necessity heretofore issued to Wm. V. Hogan, operating under the name and style of Concord Transit Co., be and they are hereby declared to have been abandoned and all tariffs and time schedules thereunder be and they are hereby cancelled.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Decisions Nos. 10842 and 12781, dated August 10, 1922 and November 5, 1923, respectively, be and they are hereby revoked and annulled.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
