ORDER AMENDING DECISION AND DENYING REHEARING

A petition for rehearing of our Decision Number 29,300 made and entered in the above entitled matter having been filed on behalf of Southern Pacific Company, Pacific Motor Transport Company and Pacific Motor Trucking Company, and good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that condition (3) appearing at page 2 of the order in Decision Number 29,300 be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

"3. The authority herein granted is limited to service to be performed in lieu of vessel service and is void as soon as the strike conditions and labor troubles now existing and upon which this order granting temporary authority is predicated have terminated."

Said decision in all other respects to remain in full force and effect; and

The Commission having considered said petition for rehearing

and being of the opinion that no good cause appears therein for the granting of a rehearing of said decision as amended herein,

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that said petition for rehearing be and the same is hereby denied.
