IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the second ordering paragraph of Decision No. 29342 in the above entitled proceedings be and it is hereby amended to read as follows:

"IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the common carrier respondents specifically named in the preceding paragraph be and they are hereby directed to establish on or before January 14, 1937, on not less than one (1) day's notice to the Commission and to the public, rates, rules and regulations no lower in volume and effect than those established and approved in this order."

Decision No. 29342 of December 9, 1936, as amended by Decisions
Nos. 29355 and 29424 shall remain in full force and effect.
