In the Matter of the Application of M. C. Yahne, Inc., a corporation, for authority to discontinue operation of a Bus service between Oceanside and Vista.

OPINION

By this application M. C. Yahne, operating under the fictitious name and style of Inland Stages, seeks permission to discontinue all his service as a certificated common carrier of passengers, baggage and express between Oceanside and Vista and intermediate points and for a further order revoking the operating right therefor.

Applicant alleges that from October 15 to October 31, 1936, only 12 passengers were transported. It is further alleged that for the complete sixty (60) day period, October through November, only 48 passengers were transported. In rendering this service applicant operated a total of 1,880 miles at an expense of \$206.80 and in return received only \$18.24 in revenue from passenger fares.

This appears to be a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary. The application will be granted.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that M. C. Yahne, Inc., operating under the fictitious name and style of Inland Stages, be and

hereby is authorized to discontinue and abandon all automotive service for the common carrier transportation of passengers, baggage and express between Oceanside and Vista and intermediate points provided that applicant shall file and make effective on at least ten (10) days notice to the Commission and the public a supplement to his tariff and a time schedule showing the abandonment of service as herein authorized and shall post notice of such discontinuance in bus terminals and passenger vehicles.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Decision No. 29048, dated August 17, 1936, be and the same hereby is revoked.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty (20) days from date hereof.
