OPINION AND ORDER

Southern Counties Gas Company has filed Revised Sheets C.R.C. Nos. 758-G to 782-G, inclusive, to supersede and take the place of existing Revised Sheets C.R.C. Nos. 715-G to 726-G, inclusive, and 747-G and 739-G, applicable to surplus natural gas service.

Public hearing appears unnecessary, and insofar as said refilings may result in increased rates or charges, because of provisions relating to contracts, it is hereby found that such increases are justified, and good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that Southern Counties Gas Company is hereby authorized to make effective, as of January 21, 1937, Revised Sheets C.R.C. Nos. 758-G to 782-G, inclusive, relating to surplus natural gas service.
