ORDER REVOKING CERTIFICATE

R. A. Mallett operating under the name and style of Mather Field Stage Line has had his automotive common carrier service for the transportation of passengers between Sacramento and Mather Field under suspension since the latter part of 1932, by authority of the Commission, and continued and extended from time to time by further orders.

By its latest Order, dated November 29, 1936, the Commission approved a continued suspension of this service to and including January 2, 1937, subject to the condition that on or before that date applicant should either resume service or relinquish his operating right.

The final suspension period having expired and R. A. Mallett having failed to notify the Commission of his resumption of service it would appear that this operating right has been abandoned and that an order revoking his certificate of public convenience and necessity should ensue.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that R. A. Mallett having failed, after due notice, to notify the Commission that he had resumed his

automotive common carrier passenger service between Sacramento and Mather Field as directed, his operating right therefor is declared to have been abandoned and all time schedules and tariffs thereunder be and they are hereby cancelled.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Decisions No.. 5297, dated April 12, 1918 on Application No. 3624, and No. 22258, dated March 26, 1930 on Application No. 16384, be and they are hereby revoked and annulled.

The effective date of this order shall be ten (10) days from date hereof.
