O P I N I O N

By his application in this matter C. O. Fraim seeks the issuance of a license authorizing him to operate as a Motor Transportation Broker, pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 705, Statutes of 1935. The granting of this application was protested by Pacific Southwest Railroad Association and by Pacific Freight Lines, Inc.

At the hearing held in this matter before Examiner Austin at Los Angeles on January 18th, 1937, no appearance was made by or on behalf of the applicant, although, as the record in this matter indicates, due notice of the hearing was given to him. In view of applicant's failure to appear, the protestants moved that the application be dismissed for want of prosecution. The motion appears to be well taken and, accordingly, it will be granted.

A public hearing having been had, the matter having been duly submitted and the Commission being now fully advised,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above entitled application be and the same is hereby dismissed for want of prosecution.
