FIFTH SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

ORIGINAL

The California Oregon Power Company which owns and operates electric plants in the States of Oregon and California, has asked permission to keep its electric accounts in the State of California, effective January 1, 1937, in accordance with the system of accounts adopted by the National Association of Railroad and Public Utility Commissioners. It represents that such system of accounts is practically identical with the system of accounts prescribed by the Federal Power Commission.

We have considered applicant's request. Heretofore we have granted several utilities which are subject to the jurisdiction of the Federal Power Commission permission to keep their electric accounts in the manner prescribed by said Federal Power Commission. We will grant The California Oregon Power Company similar permission.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Commission's order in Decision No. 11353 dated December 13, 1922, be and the same is hereby modified so as to permit The California Oregon Power Company to keep its accounts and records for its electric properties and operations in the State of California in accordance with the system of accounts for public utilities and licensees prescribed by the Federal Power Commission under its Order No. 42, adopted June 16, 1936, as amended, and that The California Oregon Power Company is hereby relieved from keeping its accounts and records in accordance with the uniform system of accounts for electrical corporations

prescribed by the order in said Decision No. 11353 dated December 13, 1922, provided that the Commission reserves the right to amend or annul this Fifth Supplemental Order and require said The California Oregon Power Company to comply with such system of accounts as the Commission may hereafter prescribe.
