FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Decision No. 29341, dated December 7, 1936, be and the same is hereby amended to include the following restriction.

"Passengers will not be carried locally between the intersection of Paramount Boulevard and Morton Street and the intersection of Imperial Highway and Rives Avenue, nor between points intermediate thereto and either of said points."

In all other respects Decision No. 29341 shall remain unchanged and in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
