receiving and discharging passengers,
a non-agency station at Haviland, in
the County of Yolo, State of California.

BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

Sacramento Northern Railway, a corporation, on March 24, 1937, applied for authority to abandon its non-agency station of Haviland, in Yolo County, as a facility for receiving and discharging passengers.

Applicant alleges that no passengers have been transported from or to said station for a period of at least five (5) months, and that there is no public demand for a continuation of passenger service to and from said point.

The California Farm Bureau Federation, on April 2, 1937, signified, in writing, that it does not object to the granting of this application.

It appearing that a public hearing is not necessary herein, and that the application should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Sacramento Northern Railway is hereby authorized to abandon its non-agency station of Haviland, in Yolo County, State of California, as a point for receiving and discharging passengers, and to cancel, in conformity with the rules of this Commission, all passenger rate tariffs and time schedules applying at said station.

Applicant shall, within thirty (30) days thereafter, notify this Commission, in writing, of the abandonment of the facilities authorized herein and of its compliance with the conditions hereof.

The authorization herein granted shall lapse and become void if not exercised within one (1) year from the date hereof, unless further time is granted by subsequent order.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
