

Decision No. 29675.

BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA.

In the Matter of the Application of SOUTHERN PACIFIC COMPANY for authority to (a) abandon the Class "A" non-agency Station of Tenant, in the County of Santa Clara, State of California, and (b) to abandon and remove, with its appurtenances, a spur track approximately 1800 feet in length, located at said station.

O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, on March 31, 1937, applied for authority to abandon its non-agency station of Tenant, Santa Clara County, and to abandon and remove a spur track approximately 1800 feet in length, located at said station.

Applicant alleges that no freight business has been transacted at said non-agency station for more than two years, and that in its opinion the continued maintenance of the non-agency is not necessary for its business or for the public.

The California Farm Bureau Federation, on April 2, 1937, signified, in writing, that it does not object to the granting of this application.

It appearing that a public hearing is not necessary herein, and that the application should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Southern Pacific Company is hereby authorized to abandon its non-agency station of Tenant, in Santa Clara County, State of California; to eliminate said non-agency name from its station records; to cancel, in conformity with the rules of this Commission, all rate tariffs and time

schedules applying at said station, and to abandon and remove a spur track approximately 1800 feet in length located at said station.

Applicant shall, within thirty (30) days thereafter, notify this Commission, in writing, of the abandonment of the facilities authorized herein and of its compliance with the conditions hereof.

The authorization herein granted shall lapse and become void if not exercised within one (1) year from the date hereof, unless further time is granted by subsequent order.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
