OPINION AND ORDER

By this application Progressive Transportation Company, Ltd., a highway contract carrier engaged in the transportation of iron and steel articles between points in southern California for Bethlehem Steel Company, seeks authority under Section 11 of the Highway Carriers' Act to perform this service at lesser charges than those accruing under the minimum rates established by Decision No. 28761, as amended, in Part "A" of Case No. 4088, and by Decision No. 29480, as modified, in Part "M" of Case No. 4088. The rates sought to be observed as minimum rates are set forth in Appendix "B" hereof.

Applicant alleges that it specializes in the transportation 2 of iron and steel articles, and operates trucks designed and equipped for the most efficient handling of these commodities. It further states that the large and continuous volume of tonnage enjoyed under contract with Bethlehem Steel Company results in a high equipment use factor, and that the nature of the loading and unloading facilities

2 The term "iron and steel articles" as used herein embraces the commodities described in Appendix "A" hereof.

¹ By Decision No. 29480 of January 25, 1937, as emended by Decision No. 39592 of March 8, 1937, in Case No. 4088 Part "M", the Commission prescribed rates for shipments of 15,000 pounds and less of the commodities here in issue within the general territory from San Fernando and Burbank, on the north to San Ysidro and the Mexican border on the south and from the Pacific Ocean on the west to Redlands, Yucaipa, Escondido and Hemet Valley on the cast. To the extent different rates are established therein they supersede the rates established by Decision No. 23761, as amended, in Case No. 4088 Part "A".

available to the applicant at points of origin and destinction obviate delays. These factors, combined with low billing, clerical and collection expense, are said to support applicant's contentions that the proposed rates are fully compensatory and will return a reasonable profit.

As additional justification, applicant points out that by Decision No. 29105 of September 14, 1936, in Application No. 20629, certain contract carriers engaged in rendering similar transportation under substantially the same conditions were authorized to charge rates the same in volume as those herein proposed.

The proposed rates are said to be satisfactory to the interested shipper.

It appears that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary, and that the application should be granted; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HERREY ORDERED that applicant Progressive Transportation Company, Ltd., a corporation, be and it is hereby authorized to assess and collect rates less than those established by the Commission in Decision No. 28761 and as amended, and in Decision No. 29480 and as amended, in Case No. 4088, but not less than the rates set forth in Appendix "B" attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof, for the transportation, for Bethlehem Steel Company, of the property described in Appendix "A" attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.
