IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Paragraph "7" of the order in
Decision No. 16258, dated March 19, 1926, reading as follows:-

" 7. Southern California Edison Company shall file with
the Railroad Commission quarterly reports showing the amount
and classes of stock issued, under the authority herein
granted, in exchange for outstanding stock, the amount and
classes of stock returned to the company for exchange, and
the expenses incurred to effect said exchange of stock; the
first of said reports to be filed on or before August 1, 1926,
and cover the period from the effective date of this order
to and including June 30, 1926, and subsequent reports to be
filed within thirty days after the end of the quarter covered
by the report"
