

Decision No. 29714

BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the matter of the application of PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY, a corporation, and IRMA DELIUS for an order of the Railroad Commission of California authorizing applicants to enter into a written indenture in the words and figures as written in the form therefor, which is referred to in this petition.

BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

In this application, Pacific Gas and Electric Company, a corporation, requests authority from the Railroad Commission to transfer a certain section of a small irrigation and domestic water canal in Placer County to Irma Delius of Alta, California. This property consists of a portion of the so-called Little Bear River ditch including its headdam and the right to divert certain waters from Little Bear River and from Alta Ravine. A field investigation having been made and it appearing that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted, now, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Pacific Gas and Electric Company, a corporation, be and it is hereby authorized to transfer to Irma Delius that certain section of canal or water ditch, together with certain water rights, substantially in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth in the form of indenture marked Exhibit "A" attached to the application herein and hereby made a part of this

Order by reference, subject to the further following condition:

The authority herein granted shall apply only to such transfer as shall have been made on or before the first day of August, 1937, and a certified copy of the final instrument of conveyance shall be filed with this Commission by Pacific Gas and Electric Company, a corporation, within thirty (30) days from the date on which it is executed.

For all other purposes the effective date of this Order shall be twenty (20) days from and after the date hereof.
