

Applicant reports that he holds consumers deposits in the sum of thirteen (\$15.) Dollars and that any deposit which is in excess of the water bill due, will be refunded by him.

The Commission has considered applicant's request and is of the opinion that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that I. W. Lampman be, and he hereby is, authorized to transfer on or before October 1, 1937 to the City of South Gate the water system known as the Magnolia Park Water Company, and comprising lot six(6) tract 5527, as per map recorded in book 59, page 100 of maps, records of Los Angeles County, subject to conditions, restrictions, reservations, rights and rights of way of record; and the water pipes, mains, valves, fittings, meters, and other personal property now a part of the distributing system of said Magnolia Park Water Company; one Byron and Jackson deep-well pump, complete with 25 H.P. motor, now being used at the pumping plant of said Magnolia Park Water Company; two (2) storage tanks, together with all pipes and fittings connected thereto.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that I. W. Lampman shall file with the Commission a copy of each deed or other instrument executed for the purpose of transferring said properties to the City of South Gate and a statement showing the exact date upon which he relinquished possession of such system.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the authority herein granted will become effective upon the date hereof.
