SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER
ON PETITION FOR REHEARING

A petition has been filed by Plymouth Water Works for a rehearing of the Commission's Decision No. 29734 of May 3, 1937, fixing the rates which this utility should charge for water service.

Upon further examination of the facts presented in this proceeding, it appears that an error obviously was made in the computation of the effect of the prescribed rates upon the anticipated net revenue resulting from their application in the future, the rates prescribed for fire hydrant service effecting an annual reduction in revenue by an amount considerably more than intended.

After further considering the matter of rates reasonably chargeable for service to the City for fire hydrants, it is our opinion that the original Order should be amended to provide for a reduction of 20 per cent on those hydrants connected to mains of 4 inches or larger in diameter, and a reduction of 25 per cent on

those connected to mains of less than 4 inches.

There appearing to be no necessity for a further hearing of the matter, a supplemental order so providing may be entered.

O R D E R

Good cause appearing, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Order made in Decision No. 29734 on May 3, 1937, be and hereby is modified to read as follows:

1. M. C. Randolph, doing business under the fictitious firm name and style of Plymouth Water Works, shall file with this Commission, within thirty (30) days from and after the date of this Order, the following schedule of rates to be charged for all water sold to his consumers in Plymouth, Amador County, subsequent to the 30th day of June, 1937:

RATE SCHEDULE

Minimum Monthly Charges:

5/8 x 3/4-inch meter-----	\$2.25
3/4-inch meter-----	2.50
1-inch meter-----	3.00
1 1/2-inch meter-----	5.00
2-inch meter-----	7.00

Each of the foregoing "Minimum Monthly Charges" will entitle the consumer to the quantity of water which that minimum monthly charge will purchase at the following Monthly Quantity Rates:

Monthly Quantity Rates:

First 600 cubic feet, or less-----	\$2.25
Next 1,400 cubic feet, per 100 cubic feet-----	.25
All over 2,000 cubic feet, per 100 cubic feet-----	.15

Municipal Use

Fire hydrants on mains four inches in diameter or larger, each per month-----	\$2.00
Fire hydrants on mains smaller than four inches in diameter, each per month-----	1.50
Water for street and road sprinkling and for sewer flushing, per 100 cubic feet-----	.15

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the petition of Plymouth Water Works for a rehearing of said Decision No. 29734 be and hereby is denied.

The effective date of this Supplemental Order shall be twenty (20) days from the date hereof.
