BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

San Diego and Arizona Eastern Railway Company, a corporation, on April 19th, 1937, applied for authority to abandon and remove an industrial spur track 515 feet in length, located at Milo Post 2.52 on its Lakeside Branch, in the City of San Diego, County of San Diego, State of California.

Applicant alleges that said track was constructed in 1914 for the purpose of serving the American Concrete Pipe Company, an industry located on Lots 21 to 37, inclusive, in Block 3, Reed's Central Addition, San Diego. The above industry removed its plant from this location in 1931, since which time the spur track has not been used for delivery or receipt of freight. The present owner of the above described property has requested applicant to remove said spur track from his property at once.

It appearing that a public hearing is not necessary herein and that the application should be granted;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that San Diego and Arizona Eastern Railway Company is hereby authorized to abandon and remove its

spur track located at Mile Post 2.52, on its Lakeside Branch in the City of San Diego, and as more definitely described in paragraph II of the application.

Applicant shall, within thirty (30) days thereafter, notify the Commission, in writing, of the abandonment of the facilities authorized herein and of its compliance with the conditions hereof.

The authorization herein granted shall lapse and become void if not exercised within one (1) year from the date hereof, unless further time is granted by subsequent order.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
