OPINION AND ORDER

This is an application for an order of the Railroad Commission authorizing G.R. Clements to transfer to George A. Chrisman his interest in certain warehouse properties heretofore operated under the firm name of Chrisman & Clements, a co-partnership.

The properties to be transferred consist of certain real property and a warehouse located at Clements, and of equipment used in the transaction of the warehouse business. The consideration for the transfer of the properties, according to an "Agreement Dissolving Co-partnership" attached to the application, is \$3500.00.

The proposed change of operation will not result in any curtailment of service; applicant George A. Chrisman will continue to operate the warehouse as a public utility under rates, rules and regulations shown in Warehouse Tariff No. 3, C.R.C. No. 3, filed in the name of the co-partnership.

We are of the opinion that this is not a matter in which a hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted; therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above entitled application be and it is hereby granted, subject to the following conditions:

1. G.R. Clements and George A. Chrisman shall join in a common supplement to the tariff now on file with the Railroad Commission, applicant G. R. Clements on the one hand withdrawing and applicant George A. Chrisman on the other hand accepting and adopting such tariff.
2. The rights and privileges herein authorized to be transferred may not be sold, leased, transferred or assigned, nor shall service thereunder be discontinued, unless the written consent of the Railroad Commission to the sale, lease, transfer or discontinuance has first been secured.

This order shall become effective on the date hereof.
