ORDER REVOKING CERTIFICATE

WHEREAS, J. J. Taylor, operating under the name and style of Big Basin Line, is the holder of a certificate of public convenience and necessity to transport, as an automotive common carrier, passengers, baggage and express between Big Basin and Santa Cruz under authority of Decision No. 25285, dated October 24, 1932, on Application No. 18412, as a seasonal service from approximately May 15th to September 30th each year and,

WHEREAS, said J. J. Taylor was authorized, by Decision No. 29879, dated June 8, 1936 on Application No. 20588, to suspend all his service for the 1936 season subject to the condition that this operator would either resume service at the beginning of his 1937 season or relinquish his operating right and,

WHEREAS, J. J. Taylor has now advised the Commission in writing under date of May 26, 1937, that he is unable to resume his service as ordered and requests authority to abandon with a further order revoking his operating right, therefore,

Good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that J. J. Taylor, operating under the name and style of Big Basin Line, be and he is hereby authorized to discontinue and abandon all his service as an automotive common carrier of passengers, baggage and express between Santa Cruz and Big Basin and all his tariffs and time schedules therefor be and they are hereby cancelled.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Decision No. 25285, dated October 24, 1932, be and the same hereby is revoked and annulled.
