BY THE COMMISSION:

NINTH SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Bakersfield and Kern Electric Railroad Company, on June 12, 1937, requested, in writing, that the rates of fare now in effect on its street railway and expiring June 30, 1937, as authorized in Decision No. 26125, dated July 5, 1933, be further extended to June 30, 1938.

It appearing that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the request should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the fares, rules and regulations authorized in Condition (1) of Decision No. 26125 be extended to and including June 30, 1938, and that Condition (2) of said Decision be modified to read as follows:

- (2) To file and make effective on July 1, 1938, and thereafter continue in force and effect the schedule of fares, rules and regulations set forth and contained in Exhibit No. 2 of the supplemental application filed June 28, 1933.

In all other respects Decision No. 26125 shall remain in full force and effect.
