## SECOND SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION

By Decision No. 29538, the First Supplemental Order in the above entitled proceedings, the Commission authorized certain changes in the rates, rules and regulations theretofore established in and by Decision No. 28810 of May 11, 1936 (40 C.R.C. 13). Thereafter, upon representations made by interested carriers that the amended rate schedules if allowed to become effective would be incomplete and inadequate, unreasonably low and non-compensatory, and that the rules and regulations would in some instances be impracticable and unduly burdensome, the Commission stayed the effective date of said Decision No. 29538. Further hearings were had at San Francisco on March 30, 31, and June 24, 1937.

In general the carriers through their Associations urged that the Commission reconsider many of their proposals found not justified or only partly justified, as well as other revisions not sponsored by the Associations. In the interest of clarity the Associations' contentions and evidence offered in support thereof will be discussed under the heading of the particular type of service involved.<sup>1</sup>

### Local moving - (a) Crated Property

The Associations seek removal of the restriction limiting crated property rates to intra-city movements, extension of Territory "B" rates from 15 to 30 miles, revision of Territory "A" rates to the basis of 120% of Territory "B" and establishment of baggage rates.

Association witnesses testified that respondent carriers' services in the transportation of crated property differ materially from those offered by other carriers in that pickups and deliveries are not limited to sidewalk, door or carrier's terminal as in the case

of other carriers but are made inside the residence at patrons' directions and in that they ordinarily perform many other accessorial services in preparing shipments for transportation and in effecting deliveries. Consequently, it is urged, that rates for crated property consisting of shipments of household goods should not be predicated upon the rates observed by carriers not specializing in the transportation of household goods and related articles and that there is no reason why crated property rates cannot be effectually extended to inter-city movements. These witnesses also stated that the transportation of baggage is a definite part of respondents' operations and that rates of the volume of those heretofore proposed should be approved.

Local Moving - (b) Uncrated Property.

The revised hourly rates for the local movement of uncrated property contained in Decision No. 29538, according to witnesses for the Associations, are inadequate and below the cost of service developed in the report of the Commission's engineer.<sup>2</sup> These witnesses also testified that the elimination of driving time to job and the reduction in the hourly rates for vehicles having a loading area of less than 90 square feet as provided in the First Supplemental Order, would reduce earnings below a compensatory level. They also criticized the use of a basis of a loading area of less than 90 square feet exclusive of tailgate for distinguishing between so-called large and small vans and trucks for rate making purposes, stating that 75% of the units now in use have a loading area of less than 90 square feet, exclusive of tailgate. They suggested that the existing hourly rates now applicable regardless of the size of the vehicle employed, be restricted to vehicles having a loading area of 75 square feet, exclusive of tailgate or 90 square feet, including tailgate, and that hourly rates for

larger equipment be established on a basis of 50 cents over the existing rates. In addition, the Associations urged that the provision in the rule for computing time to include driving time to the job, (not to exceed 15 minutes) be restored.<sup>3</sup>

Witnesses for San Francisco Movers Inc., and Draymen's Association of Alameda County testified that subsequent to the issuance of The First Supplemental Order their organizations have negotiated new wage agreements with representatives of drivers and helpers. Accordingly, they asserted, that effective June 1, 1937, in San Francisco and June 5, 1937, in Alameda County, wages were increased by \$1.00 per day for straight time, with a relative increase in overtime rates and additional compensation for helpers employed less than a full day. Increases in operating cost attributable to the rising cost of materials, rent, insurance and supplies were also stressed. Witness Barker introduced a cost study which purports to show that since the introduction of the initial cost study in these proceedings (Exhibit No. 1) the cost of operating large equipment with driver and helper has increased 79 cents per hour. Although the witness had made no computation of increased cost for small equipment he expressed the opinion that the increase for such vehicles would be substantially the same as that for the larger units. San Francisco movers Inc., and Draymen's Association of Alameda County, therefore, strongly urged that the existing minimum hourly rates for the transportation of property in Territory "A" be increased sufficiently to offset the increased operating expenses experienced by the carriers.

The rates prescribed in the First Supplemental Order for "piece moving" are also said to be unduly low and less than half the lowest rates in effect for this type of service for at least fifteen years. Particular

stress was laid on the insufficiency of these rates for the transportation of pianos, mechanical refrigerators and stoves or ranges. It is strongly urged that rates higher than those applying to other piece moving are justified for the movement of these commodities because their transportation characteristics are said to be such that they must be given more than ordinary care in handling necessitating the employment of specially trained men.

Association witnesses also expressed dissatisfaction with the rate bases established for the transportation of consolidated lots. For intra-city movements they urged that driving time be computed from first pick-up to last delivery instead of from last pick-up to first delivery as provided in the First Supplemental Order. For inter-city movements in the Los Angeles metropolitan area they stated that hourly rather than weight rates are desirable due to the fact that the circumstances and conditions surrounding many of the inter-city movements in the vicinity of Los Angeles are almost identical with those attending intra-city movements within Los Angeles.

#### Long Distance Moving

Witnesses representing the Associations directed attention to the fact that many of the point to point rates for long distance moving are mere "paper rates" because the alternatively applicable distance rates result in lower charges for the same service. They advocated adjusting the point to point rates to the level of the distance rates. This adjustment, according to the witnesses, will avoid considerable confusion and controversy in the computation of transportation charges, particularly when movements over toll bridges or ferries are involved, requiring carriers to compute distance rates plus actual tolls. They also proposed a flat charge of 10 cents per 100 pounds to be added to distance rates where the transportation involves the use of toll bridges or ferries, in lieu of adding the actual toll to the transportation charge. This change, it was testified, will greatly simplify the quotation of rates and computation of charges, and according to the testimony and exhibits of record will result in the collection of substantially the same gross transportation charges.

Other Association proposals include a uniform storage charge on shipments on which delivery cannot be effected on arrival of carrier's equipment; the imposition of local moving rates in addition to the otherwise established rates for long distance moving on shipments of less than 1,000 pounds; and a so-called cubic foot rule on bulky shipments. All are said to be necessary to round out a complete rate schedule and to prevent depletion of carrier revenues.

Accessorial Service

Crating and uncrating are considered by the Associations as essential parts of the household goods moving industry, requiring adequate minimum rates not only to compensate carriers properly for the rendition of these services but also to prevent some carriers from charging subnormal crating and uncrating rates as a means of securing traffic in competition with other carriers. Association witnesses stated that custom and the convenience of patrons prompted them to recommend the establishment of crating and uncrating rates on a weight basis predicated upon the average time consumed in performing these services.

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The Los Angeles Transfer Company opposed the establishment of minimum rates for the movement of baggage. Its counsel drew admissions from Association witnesses that all but a small percentage of baggage is transported under satisfactory contractual arrangement with common carriers as incidental to the transportation of persons by such carriers. Los Angeles Transfer Company contends therefore that there is no need to disturb the present arrangement under which all movement of any consequence is handled merely to provide rates on an inconsequential portion of the baggage traffic.

With the single exception of rates for the movement of baggage no one opposed the Associations' proposals. Considerable stress was laid upon the absence of opposition as well as the unanimity of opinion among

the carriers with respect to these proposals. It should be observed, however, that due to the very nature of the traffic here involved, household shippers as a group can hardly be expected to manifest the same degree of interest in transportation rate proceedings as commercial houses and firms shipping the many thousands of articles merchandised by them. In the one case the householder rarely contemplates more than one transportation transaction at a time, while in the other, the commercial firm must of necessity be ever watchful of its present and future transportation costs as an element of its general operating expenses. In the light of these circumstances the absence of opposition to carrier proposals loses much of its force. Therefore, in establishing minimum rates for the transportation of household goods on a record almost entirely devoid of any shipper testimony the Commission should be doubly cautious in its analysis of the evidence to safeguard against the possible fixation of unreasonable or discriminatory rates, rules or regulations.

The record is convincing that minimum rates for the transportation of crated property in Territory "B" should be extended from 15 to 30 miles, that crated property rates in Territory "A" should be 20% higher than those established for movements in Territory "B" and that these rates should be prescribed for inter-city movements.

There is abundant evidence to justify the re-establishment of minimum rates for the transportation of uncrated property in local moving, in vans and trucks having a loading area including tailgate, of 90 square feet or more on a basis of 50 cents per hour over the

existing rates. The latter rates, for the future, will be restricted to transportation in vans and trucks having a loading area including tailgate of less than 90 square feet. A further increase in the hourly rates for Territory "A" is also justified. The increases authorized in the order herein should reasonably offset the increased costs experienced by the carriers in this territory. The record is also persuasive that rates for "piece moving" should be readjusted to provide two scales of rates, one scale to apply in connection with heavy or bulky articles and the other on articles of 15 cubic feet and less and 150 pounds and less. Specific commodity rates for the movement of pianos and refrigerators are also justified. It seems clear that the hourly rates for consolidated lots contained in the First Supplemental Order for application on intra-city traffic should be extended to apply on inter-city traffic within the metropolitan area of Los Angeles.

Two changes in the existing long distance moving rates have been shown to be necessary to avoid confusion in the application of rates and computation of charges. The first involves the realignment of the point to point rates and the second the restatement of the manner in which bridge and ferry tolls shall be billed on shipments moving under distance rates. According to the record neither change will affect the carriers' revenues.

In all other respects the proposals have not been justified.

It may well be that certain of the proposals found not justified or found only partially justified are meritorious, but unless or until they are supported by convincing evidence they cannot be approved. In this connection it should be observed that a mere showing of past practice or a statement of the desirability of an adjustment from the carriers' standpoint is insufficient to sustain the burden of proof that modifications or revisions of established rates are justified.

## FINDINGS

Upon consideration of all the facts of record I am of the opinion and find:

1. That the existing rates, rules and regulations charged, collected and observed by respondent common carriers for transportation and accessorial services for which rates are provided in Appendix "A" attached to the order herein, to the extent that they are lower in volume or effect than the rates, rules and regulations set forth in said Appendix "A", are unreasonable, insufficient, and not justified by the actual competitive transportation rates of competing carriers nor by the costs of other means of transportation.
2. That rates, rules and regulations no lower in volume and effect than those set forth in Appendix "A" should be prescribed as reasonable and sufficient rates, rules and regulations for common carriers.
3. That the rates, rules and regulations set forth in Appendix "A" are justified and should be established as the just, reasonable and non-discriminatory rates, rules and regulations for transportation and accessorial services for which rates are provided in said Appendix "A" by radial highway common carriers, highway contract carriers and city carriers.
4. That respondent common carriers, radial highway common carriers, highway contract carriers and city carriers will not for the future be justified in charging, collecting or observing rates, rules or regulations, for transportation or accessorial services for which rates are provided in Appendix "A" lower in volume or effect than those set forth in said Appendix "A".
5. That the rates, rules and regulations set forth in Appendix "A" will provide an equality of transportation rates between competing agencies of transportation.

6. That Decisions Nos. 28810 of May 11, 1936, and 29538 of February 13, 1937, in these proceedings should be vacated and set aside.

The following form of order is recommended:

O R D E R

Public hearings having been held in the above entitled proceedings, and based upon the evidence received at the hearings and upon the conclusions and findings set forth in the preceding opinion,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Argonne Van & Storage Company, Baker Transfer and Storage Company, Bekins Van Lines, Inc., C. A. Buck, City Transfer Company, Dowd's Fashion Stables, Electric Transfer and Storage Company, Griggs Van Lines, Chas. Kuppinger Company, Liberty Van Line, Lyon Van Lines, Inc., Nickell Transfer Company, Stockton Transfer Company, Triangle Transfer and Storage Company and U. C. Express and Storage Company be and they are hereby ordered and directed to establish on or before forty (40) days from the effective date of this order, on not less than twenty (20) days' notice to the Commission and to the public, rates, rules and regulations no lower in volume or effect than those set forth in Appendix "A" attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof, for transportation and accessorial services for which rates are provided in said appendix "A".

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the rates, rules and regulations set forth in said Appendix "A" be and they are hereby established and approved effective forty (40) days from the effective date of this order as the just, reasonable and non-discriminatory minimum rates, rules and regulations to be charged, collected and observed by any and all radial highway common carriers and highway contract car-

riers as defined in the Highway Carriers' Act (Chapter 223, Statutes of 1935) and by any and all carriers as defined in the City Carriers' Act (Chapter 312, Statutes of 1935) for transportation and accessorial services for which rates are provided in said Appendix "A".

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that all respondents in these proceedings be and they are hereby ordered to cease and desist on or before forty (40) days from the effective date of this order and thereafter abstain from charging, collecting or observing rates, rules and regulations lower in volume or effect than those set forth in said Appendix "A".

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that to the extent the rates, rules and regulations herein established for the same transportation and accessorial services are different from those established in and by:

1. Decisions Nos. 28761 of April 27, 1936, and 28831 of May 22, 1936, in Part "A" of Case No. 4088,

2. Decisions Nos. 29342 of December 7, 1936, and 29355 of December 9, 1936, in Part "J" of Case No. 4088,

3. Decision No. 29554 of February 19, 1937, in Part "S" of Case No. 4088,

the rates, rules and regulations herein established shall supersede such rates, rules and regulations established in and by said decisions.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Decisions Nos. 28810 of May 11, 1936, and 29538 of February 13, 1937, in these proceedings, be and they are hereby vacated and set aside.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that every radial highway common carrier, highway contract carrier and city carrier shall issue to the shipper for each shipment received for transportation, a freight bill in substantially the form set forth in Appendix "B" attached

hereto and by this reference made a part hereof, but may include in said freight bill in addition to the provisions appearing in said form, such other reasonable and lawful provisions as may be deemed proper, and shall retain and preserve a copy of said freight bill for a period of not less than three (3) years from the date of its issuance.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the Commission shall have and it does hereby retain jurisdiction of these proceedings for the purpose of establishing or approving the just, reasonable and non-discriminatory maximum or minimum, or maximum and minimum rates, charges, rules and regulations to be charged, collected and observed by radial highway common carriers, highway contract carriers and city carriers both for the transportation service hereinabove described and for such other transportation and accessorial service as may from time to time appear proper in the light of other or future evidence received herein and for the purpose of establishing and prescribing such rates as will provide an equality of transportation rates for the transportation of the articles and commodities here involved between all competing agencies of transportation.

The effective date of this order shall be thirty (30) days from the date hereof.

The foregoing opinion and order are hereby approved and ordered filed as the opinion and order of the Railroad Commission of the State of California.

### EXPLANATION OF ABBREVIATIONS

A.Q. .... Any Quantity N.O.S. ... Not otherwise specified in this appendix  
C.O.D. ..... Collect on Delivery No. ..... Number

### DEFINITION OF TECHNICAL TERMS

- (a) POINT OF ORIGIN means the precise location at which property is picked up or to be picked up and loaded in or on equipment of the carrier for transportation.
- (b) POINT OF DESTINATION means the precise location at which property is discharged or to be discharged from the equipment of the carrier.
- (c) SHIPMENT means a quantity of freight received from one shipper on one shipping order or one bill of lading, at one point of origin, at one time, for one consignee, at one destination.
- (d) CRATED PROPERTY means property securely packed in salesmen's hand sample cases, suit cases, overnight or boston bags, brief cases, hat boxes, valises, travelling bags, trunks, lift vans, barrels, boxes, cartons, crates, cases, baskets, pails, kits, tubs, drums, bags (jute, cotton, burlap or gunny) or bundles (completely wrapped in jute, cotton, burlap, gunny, fibreboard, or straw matting).
- (e) UNCRATED PROPERTY means property not packed in accordance with the requirements of paragraph (d) hereof.
- (f) CRATING means any accessorial service performed in preparing a shipment for transportation.
- (g) UNCRATING means any accessorial service performed in connection with the delivery of a shipment.
- (h) PACKING means the accessorial service of protecting any portion of a shipment by placing it in containers.
- (i) UNPACKING means the accessorial service of removing any portion of a shipment from containers.
- (j) PIECE MOVING means the transportation of a shipment of uncrated property consisting of not more than five (5) articles.
- (k) VEHICLE means any motor truck, tractor, or other self-propelled vehicle, any trailer, semi-trailer, or other vehicles drawn thereby, or any combination of such vehicles moving as a single unit.
- (l) LIFT VAN means any vehicle body having a cubic measurement in excess of 250 cubic feet that is designed to be removed from the vehicle's chassis and to be used as a shipping container.

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SECTION NO. 1 - RULES AND REGULATIONS

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RULE NO. 10 - APPLICATION OF APPENDIX

(a) Except as otherwise provided the rates named in this appendix apply to the transportation of used property viz., household goods, personal effects, furniture, musical instruments, radios, office and store fixtures and equipment.

(b) This appendix does not apply to:

(1) The transportation from or to a depot, dock or other point where passengers are received or discharged, of baggage, viz., personal baggage consisting of wearing apparel, toilet articles and similar personal effects, not intended for other persons nor for sale; and sample baggage, consisting of baggage for commercial as distinguished from personal use such as catalogues, models and samples of goods, wares or merchandise tendered as baggage to be used in making sales or other disposition of the goods, wares or merchandise represented thereby.

(2) The transportation of crated property for distances in excess of 30 miles except shipments between points in metropolitan Los Angeles as described in Rule No. 40(e).

RULE NO. 20 - APPLICATION OF APPENDIX - TERRITORIAL DESCRIPTION

(a) Where transportation rates or transportation and accessorial service rates refer to Territory "A" such rates shall apply when the point of origin is within the City and County of San Francisco, the Counties of Alameda or San Mateo or the Cities of Palo Alto or Richmond.

(b) Where transportation rates or transportation and accessorial service rates refer to Territory "B" such rates shall apply when the point of origin is not located within the territory described in paragraph (a) hereof.

(c) Where rates for accessorial service are separately stated and reference is made to Territories "A" or "B" the location of the point where such accessorial service is performed determines which rates shall be assessed. Territory "A" rates shall apply at all points within the City and County of San Francisco, the Counties of Alameda and San Mateo and the Cities of Palo Alto and Richmond. Territory "B" rates shall apply at all other points.

RULE NO. 30 - APPLICATION OF RATES PROVIDED IN SECTION NO. 2 -  
(LOCAL MOVING)

(a) Rates named in Section No. 2 apply on shipments transported 30 miles and less and on shipments transported in excess of 30 miles between points in metropolitan Los Angeles as described in Rule No. 40(e).

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SECTION NO. 1 - RULES AND REGULATIONS (Continued)

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RULE NO. 30 - APPLICATION OF RATES PROVIDED IN  
SECTION NO. 2 (LOCAL MOVING) (Concluded)

(b) Except as provided in paragraph (c) (1) hereof, hourly rates named in Section No. 2 shall be computed as follows: Loading time plus double the driving time from point of origin to point of destination plus unloading time.

(c) When two or more shipments of uncrated property are offered to a carrier for consolidation and transportation in or on one vehicle and the carrier is able to effect such consolidation, rates shall be computed as follows:

(1) For intra-city movements and for inter-city movements between points in metropolitan Los Angeles as described in Rule No. 40(e): The hourly rates named in Item No. 200 subject to the following basis for computing time shall be observed: For each shipment included in the consolidated lot time shall be computed as follows: Loading time plus 15 minutes for driving time plus unloading time. Each shipment shall be subject to minimum charges provided in Item No. 200.

(2) For inter-city movements: (Exception to Hourly Rates:) Except between points in metropolitan Los Angeles, as described in Rule No. 40(e), weight rates computed as follows shall be observed: The minimum rate for each shipment shall be computed on the basis of 1½ cents per 100 pounds per mile plus 40 cents per 100 pounds, but in no event shall the resulting rate be less than 70 cents per 100 pounds when the point of origin is within Territory "A", or 60 cents per 100 pounds when the point of origin is within Territory "B". Distances shall be computed over the shortest public highway route regardless of route of movement.

(d) In computing time under the basis outlined in paragraphs (b) and (c) (1) hereof the various time factors shall be not less than the actual time involved in minutes, except that the driving of 15 minutes provided in paragraph (c) (1) hereof applies regardless of actual driving time. After the total time has been determined, convert it into hours and minutes and dispose of the minutes in accordance with the following table:

Less than 15 minutes -- omit.

15 minutes or more but not more than 44 minutes shall be counted as  $\frac{1}{2}$  hour.

45 minutes or more shall be counted as 1 hour.

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SECTION NO. 1 - RULES AND REGULATIONS (Continued)

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RULE NO. 40 - APPLICATION OF RATES PROVIDED IN  
SECTION NO. 3 (LONG DISTANCE MOVING)

(a) Rates named in Section No. 3 apply on shipments of uncrated property transported in excess of 30 miles, except shipments transported between points in metropolitan Los Angeles as described in paragraph (e) hereof. On mixed shipments of crated and uncrated property rated as uncrated property under the provisions of Rule No. 60(b) charges for packing and unpacking shall be made at rates named in Section No. 4.

(b) Except as otherwise provided in paragraphs (e), (f), (g), (h) and (i) hereof, the specific rates for uncrated property named in Section No. 3 include all points of origin and destination within the corporate limits of incorporated communities and all points of origin and destination within the commercial and residential limits of unincorporated communities.

(c) When specific rates for the transportation of uncrated property are named in Section No. 3, such rates shall apply unless:

- (1) The charges accruing under the distance rates shown in Item No. 300 are lower.
- (2) A combination of distance and specific rates or a combination of specific rates produces a lower charge. See Note 1.

(d) Rates for the transportation of uncrated property moving from, to or between points not specifically named in Section No. 3 shall be no lower than the specific rates named from, to or between the next more distant point or points, unless:

- (1) The charges accruing under the distance rates shown in Item No. 300 are lower.
- (2) A combination of distance and specific rates or a combination of specific rates produces a lower charge. See Note 1.

(e) Metropolitan Los Angeles as used in this appendix includes all points of origin and destination within the following boundaries:

Beginning at the intersection of the Los Angeles-Orange County Line, with the Pacific Ocean, thence westerly and northerly along the coast line to its intersection with the projection southerly of the line of Topanga Canyon Road; thence northerly along said projection, Topanga Canyon Road and Topanga Canyon Boulevard to Devonshire Street; thence easterly along Devonshire Street to Sepulveda Boulevard; thence northerly and northeasterly along Sepulveda Boulevard and Chatsworth Drive to San Fernando Road (U.S.99); thence northwesterly and northeasterly along San Fernando Road, McClay Avenue and Pacoima Canyon Road to the southerly boundary of the Angeles National Forest; thence easterly along said southerly boundary of the Angeles National Forest to the San Gabriel

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RULE NO. 40 - APPLICATION OF RATES PROVIDED IN  
SECTION NO. 3 (LONG DISTANCE MOVING) (Concluded)

Forest Highway; thence southerly along San Gabriel Forest Highway and Azusa Avenue to U.S. Highway 60; thence westerly and southwesterly along U.S. Highway 60, Sunset Avenue, Seventh Avenue, Turnbull Canyon Road to Greenleaf Avenue in Whittier; thence southerly along Greenleaf Avenue to U.S. Highway 101; thence southeasterly along U.S. Highway 101 to the Los Angeles-Orange County line; thence southerly, westerly and southwesterly along said County line to the point of beginning. Where the boundary line intersects the limits of an incorporated city, the boundary line shall follow the city limits so as to include the entire city within the boundary. Where a road or highway is used as a boundary line in unincorporated territory, all points not more than 500 feet beyond the road or highway shall be included within the boundary.

(f) Metropolitan Oakland as used in this appendix includes all points of origin and destination within the corporate limits of Alameda, Oakland, Emeryville, Piedmont, Berkeley, Albany, El Cerrito, Richmond and San Leandro.

(g) Metropolitan San Diego as used in this appendix includes all points of origin and destination within the corporate limits of San Diego, La Mesa, El Cajon, Coronado, National City and Chula Vista.

(h) Imperial Valley Group as used in this appendix includes all points of origin and destination within the corporate limits of El Centro, Calexico, Imperial, Holtville and Brawley.

(i) San Rafael Group as used in this appendix includes all points of origin and destination within the corporate limits of San Rafael, Mill Valley, Belvedere, Corte Madera, Larkspur, Ross, San Anselmo and Fairfax.

NOTE 1: (a) To compute charges under combinations of distance and specific rates or under combinations of specific rates the rates provided for any quantity shipments shall be used as the basis for determining the through rate. The second and each succeeding rate used as a rate factor in computing the through rate shall be reduced 40 cents per 100 pounds.

(b) Charges for shipments weighing not less than 2,000 pounds shall be computed at not less than 90% of the through rate calculated in accordance with the provisions of paragraph (a) of this note subject to a minimum rate of 95 cents per 100 pounds.

(c) Charges for shipments weighing not less than 4,000 pounds shall be computed at not less than 80% of the through rate calculated in accordance with the provisions of paragraph (a) of this note subject to a minimum rate of 132 cents per 100 pounds.

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## SECTION NO. 1 - RULES AND REGULATIONS (Continued)

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### RULE NO. 50 - APPLICATION OF RATES PROVIDED IN SECTION NO. 4 (ACCESSORIAL SERVICES)

Rates named in Section No. 4 apply on accessorial services viz., crating, uncrating and delivery of shipping containers.

### RULE NO. 60 - MIXED SHIPMENTS OF CRATED AND UNCRATED PROPERTY

(a) Rates named in Item No. 200 for the transportation of uncrated property shall also apply on mixed shipments of crated and uncrated property.

(b) When any portion of a shipment of uncrated property to be transported under rates named in Section No. 3 requires protection against breakage and the carrier affords protection by packing any portion of the shipment in containers the entire shipment shall be considered uncrated property and rated as such.

### RULE NO. 70 - PICKUP AND DELIVERY

(a) Hourly rates for uncrated property include pickup and delivery.

(b) Piece moving rates, crated property rates, baggage rates and long distance moving rates include ground floor pickup and delivery. (See Note.) When shipments are accorded pickup, delivery or pickup and delivery at other than the ground floor, add the following charges per flight: (See Note)

Piece Moving, viz:

Refrigerators and Pianos,	
as described in Item No. 220 ..	\$1.00 per article
Uncrated Property, N.O.S. ....	.25 per article

Crated Property, viz:

Baggage, as described in Item

NOTE: (a) A series of not more than 7 steps shall be considered ground floor; a series of 8 and not more than 20 steps shall be considered one flight; and each series of not more than 20 steps thereafter shall be considered as an additional flight.

(b) Elevator service other than vehicular elevator service shall be equivalent to one flight of stairs.

(c) Pickup and delivery at all floors of single dwellings shall be considered ground floor.

(d) Pickup and delivery at all floors reached by vehicular elevator or vehicular ramp shall be considered ground floor.

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SECTION NO. 1 - RULES AND REGULATIONS (Continued)

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RULE NO. 80 - BRIDGE AND FERRY TOLLS

(APPLIES ONLY IN CONNECTION WITH LOADED MOVEMENT)

(a) A charge of 10 cents per 100 pounds per crossing in addition to the transportation charges shall be made when toll bridges or ferries are used by a carrier in transporting shipments of uncrated property subject to the rates named in Item No. 300 or to the rates named in Rule No. 30(c)(2).

(b) On shipments subject to hourly rates the actual bridge or ferry tolls shall be added to the transportation charge when such facilities are used by the carrier.

RULE NO. 90 - RATES NAMED IN THIS APPENDIX VERSUS COMMON CARRIER RATES

In the event the application of the common carrier intra-state rates, rules and regulations for the same transportation of the same shipment of property from and to the same points and for the same accessorial services results in a lower aggregate charge than the charge resulting from the application of the rates named herein, such lower charge shall apply.

RULE NO. 100 - ACTUAL WEIGHT VERSUS MINIMUM WEIGHT

When the charges accruing on a shipment based on actual weight exceed the charges computed from a rate based on the next greater unit of minimum weight, the latter will apply.

RULE NO. 110 - DISPOSITION OF FRACTIONS

(a) Except as otherwise provided in paragraph (b) hereof, in computing a rate based on a percentage of another rate, the following rule shall be observed in the disposition of fractions:

Fractions of less than  $\frac{1}{2}$  or .50 of a cent -- omit.

Fractions of  $\frac{1}{2}$  or .50 of a cent or greater increase to next whole figure.

(b) In computing any quantity rates under Item No. 300 fractional parts of a dollar shall be disposed of as follows: (See Note).

Decimals of less than \$.025 -- omit.

" " \$.025 and over but not over \$.075 shall be stated as \$.05.

" " over \$.075 shall be stated as \$.10.

NOTE: To compute a rate based on a percentage of the any quantity rate named in Item No. 300 first dispose of fractional parts of a dollar in accordance with paragraph (b) hereof, then apply the applicable percentage disposing of resulting fractions in accordance with paragraph (a) hereof.

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SECTION NO. 1 - RULES AND REGULATIONS (Continued)

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RULE NO. 120 - VALUATION (APPLIES ONLY IN CONNECTION WITH  
RATES IN CENTS PER 100 POUNDS)

Rates named in this appendix apply on property, the declared value of which does not exceed ten cents per pound. (See Note).

NOTE: (a) When declared value exceeds ten cents per pound, but does not exceed twenty cents per pound, add 25% to rates provided in this appendix.

(b) When declared value exceeds twenty cents per pound, but does not exceed fifty cents per pound, add 50% to rates provided in this appendix.

(c) When declared value exceeds fifty cents per pound a charge of fifteen cents per \$100.00 of valuation per 100 pounds shall be assessed in addition to the rate set forth in paragraph (b) of this rule for each \$100.00 or fraction thereof of valuation per 100 pounds in excess of fifty cents per pound.

(d) Shippers are required to state specifically in writing the agreed or declared value of the property to be transported. If shipper declines to declare the value or agree to a released value in writing the shipment will not be accepted. The agreed or declared value shall be deemed to relate to all services undertaken by the carrier or its agents and to each article separately and not to a shipment as a whole. Shippers may declare on specific articles a valuation in excess of the value declared on the shipment as a whole, and each such article must be described and its excess declared value set forth.

(e) Declaration of value shall be set forth in the following form:

"The agreed or declared value of the property to be transported is hereby specifically stated by the shipper to be not in excess of \_\_\_\_\_¢ per pound, per article."

RULE NO. 130 - C. O. D. SHIPMENTS

(a) In the event a carrier elects to handle C.O.D. shipments, the carrier shall immediately upon collection of any and all moneys, and in no event later than ten (10) days after delivery to the consignee, unless consignor, in writing, instructs otherwise, remit to consignor all moneys collected by it on each shipment.

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RULE NO. 130 - C.O.D. SHIPMENTS (Concluded)

RULE NO. 150 - OVERTIME (APPLIES ONLY IN CONNECTION WITH RATES NAMED IN SECTIONS NOS. 2 AND 4)

Service performed on customer's instructions between the hours of 5:30 P.M. and 7:30 A.M., or on Sundays and the following holidays shall be considered OVERTIME and a penalty of 25% shall be added to the rates provided herein for such service:
