After investigation it appearing that the execution of said lease will in no way result in the discontinuance or impairment of applicant's public utility water service and it further appearing that a public hearing in this matter is not necessary and that the application should be granted, now, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that East Gardena Water Company be

and it is hereby authorized to execute a lease to Willard W. Cutler, Jr., of Los Angeles, California, under substantially the same terms and conditions as are set forth in the form therefor attached to the application herein and made a part of this Order by reference.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that East Gardena Water Company file with this Commission, within thirty (30) days from and after the date hereof, two certified copies of said lease as finally executed.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
