FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Great Northern Railway Company, interested party herein, on June 25, 1937, requested, in writing, that condition (6) of Decision No. 28563, dated February 10, 1936, be modified in order that the temporary grade crossing provided for therein may be retained as a private crossing. Applicant advises the Commission, in writing, that it does not object to the granting of said request.

It appears that the request is reasonable and should be granted, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that condition (6) of Docision No. 28563 be amended to read as follows:

(6) During the construction of said grade separation, Applicant may construct a temporary crossing at grade in the vicinity of said separation for the convenience of vehicles and other road traffic. Upon the completion of the grade separation herein authorized and upon its being opened to traffic, the said grade crossing shall be maintained by the Great Northern Railway Company solely as a private crossing with no obligation imposed on the State of California either to construct or maintain said crossing and said railway company shall so protect such private crossing so as to preclude its use by the public generally and particularly by through traffic.

In all other respects Decision No. 28563 shall remain in
