ORDER

WHEREAS, McFarland Telephone Company, operating a telephone system in the unincorporated town of McFarland and vicinity, has filed an application with this Commission requesting authority to file and to make effective a rate of five (5) cents for each local telephone message from a public pay station; and

WHEREAS, the furnishing of public pay station service is in the interest of the subscribers and users of the telephone service of McFarland Telephone Company; and it appearing that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is required,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that McFarland Telephone Company be and it is hereby authorized to charge and collect the sum of five (5) cents for each local telephone message from any of its public pay stations on and after August 1, 1937.

The authority herein granted is subject to the condition that the necessary rate schedule be submitted for filing with the Railroad Commission in accordance with General Order No. 68, on or before July 15, 1937.
