Edward Malde, doing business as A-B-C Transfer & Storage Co., having filed with the Railroad Commission his verified application for authority to transport household goods, furniture and personal effects as more particularly described in said application for the United States Navy Department between points in the San Francisco Bay area as more specifically set forth in said application, under contract with the United States Government, at rates and charges named in contract attached to the application, and

It appearing from said application and contract attached thereto that in the majority of instances rates the same as or in excess of minimum rates presently in effect for the same transportation will be observed and only in rare instances will rates lower than those established by the Commission be assessed, and

It further appearing from said application and contract attached thereto that said rates proposed for the performance of said transportation for the United States Navy Department are reasonable in that they will not constitute any unjust or unreasonable discrimination against other shippers or traffic;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that said application be and it is hereby granted.

The authority herein granted shall expire October 1, 1937, unless extended by order of the Commission.
