ORDER OF DISMISSAL

By this application, filed under section 47(b) of the Public Utilities Act, the City of Burbank requested the Commission to determine the just compensation to be paid for certain properties of Southern California Edison Company, Ltd. Because of the possibility of reaching a settlement through informal negotiations the matter was removed from the calendar at the request of both parties. Such negotiations were successful, the parties joined in an application to transfer the properties, and appropriate authorization was granted. (Decision 27490, App. 19677.) Good cause appearing, IT IS ORDERED that App. 19169 is hereby dismissed without prejudice.
