ORDER

The County of Merced is authorized to construct County Road (Yam Road) at grade across main line track of The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company at the location shown on the map attached to the application, to be identified as Crossing No. 2-1059.2. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense and also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company shall bear maintenance costs between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than twenty-four feet and grades of approach not greater than six per cent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (G.O. No. 75-A).

Upon completion, Crossing No. 2-1059.2, southerly, shall be abandoned and closed.

Within thirty days after completion, pursuant to this Order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year (unless time be extended), or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety require.
