BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

It appears from the above application that no passenger or freight business has been transacted at applicant's station of Burling in the County of Tulare, for more than two years, and that continued maintenance thereof is unnecessary. California Farm Bureau Federation has signified in writing that it has no objection to abandonment.

Good Cause Appearing, Southern Pacific Company is authorized to abandon its non-agency station at Burling, County of Tulare; to abandon and remove a spur track approximately 1005 feet in length at said station; to eliminate said name from its station records; and to cancel all tariffs and time schedules applying at said station. Within thirty days after abandonment, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time is extended. This Order shall become effective immediately.
