


ORIGINAL

O R D E R

It appears from the above application that the number of passengers carried and the passenger revenue accruing to applicant do not justify the continued operation of passenger service between Searles, Kern County, on the one hand, and West End, San Bernardino County, on the other hand, and that the public will not be unduly inconvenienced by the proposed discontinuance of passenger service.

Good Cause Appearing, Trona Railway Company is authorized to discontinue passenger service between Searles, Kern County, and West End, San Bernardino County, State of California, and to cancel all passenger tariffs and passenger time schedules applying between said points. Within thirty days after abandonment, applicant shall so notify the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended. This Order shall become effective immediately.
