ORDER

It appears from the above application that no freight business has been transacted at applicant's carload and less than carload freight station of Albarnes, in the County of Los Angeles, for the past twelve (12) months, except carload shipments of circus material for Al G. Barnes Circus Company. No further shipments are expected for the reason that Al G. Barnes Circus Company, which maintained its winter quarters at or near said station, has moved from said location, and the property formerly occupied is to be sub-divided. The California Farm Bureau Federation has signified, in writing, that it has no objection to the discontinuance as proposed herein.

Good cause appearing, the Pacific Electric Railway Company is authorized to discontinue its carload and less than carload non-agency freight station at Albarnes, County of Los Angeles; to eliminate said name from its station records and to cancel all tariffs applying at said station. Within thirty (30) days after discontinuance, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void

if not exercised within one year unless the time is extended.

This order shall become effective immediately.
