In the Matter of the Application of SOUTHERN PACIFIC COMPANY for an order authorizing the construction at grade of a side track across 53rd Street, in the Town of Emeryville, County of Alameda, State of California.

O R D E R

ORIGINAL

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct one side track at grade across 53rd Street, in Emeryville, Alameda County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. A-7.47-C. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 3 of G. O. No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of that street now graded, with tops of rails flush with roadway, and with grades of approach not exceeding two per cent. Protection shall be by existing two Standard No. 1 crossing signs. (G. O. No. 75-A.)

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise this Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year (unless time be extended), or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require.

This order shall be effective immediately.
