In the Matter of the Application of SOUTHERN PACIFIC COMPANY for authority (a) to abandon the non-agency station of Eva, in Santa Clara County, California, and (b) to abandon passing track 1361 feet in length and spur track 645 feet in length at said station.

It appears from the above application that no passenger or freight business has been transacted at applicant's station of Eva, in Santa Clara County, for more than two years, and that continued maintenance thereof (including passing and spur track) is not necessary.

GOOD CAUSE APPEARING, Southern Pacific Company is authorized to abandon its non-agency station of Eva, County of Santa Clara; to eliminate said name from its station records, to cancel all tariffs and time schedules applying at said station; and to abandon passing track and spur track located thereat. Within thirty days after abandonment applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended.

This order shall be effective immediately.
