In the Matter of the Application of SOUTHERN PACIFIC COMPANY for authority (a) to abandon the non-agency station of Coburn, in Monterey County, California, and (b) to abandon spur track 900 feet in length and loading platform 10' x 69' at said station.

It appears from the above application that no passenger or freight business has been transacted at applicant's station of Coburn, Monterey County, for more than two years and that continued maintenance thereof (including spur track) is not necessary.

GOOD CAUSE APPEARING, Southern Pacific Company is authorized to abandon its non-agency station of Coburn, County of Monterey; to eliminate said name from its station records; to cancel all tariffs and time schedules applying at said station; and to abandon spur track and loading platform located thereat. Within thirty days after abandonment applicant shall so notify the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended.

This order shall be effective immediately.
