SECOND SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

In Decision No. 29507 in the above entitled application, applicant was granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate a motor boat service for the transportation of passengers and their hand baggage between the Port of Santa Monica and the Port of Avalon, County of Los Angeles, during the summer season from approximately June 1 to September 15 of each year, with the requirement that applicant commence said service not later than May 31, 1937. This date was subsequently extended by supplemental order to June 30, for the year 1937 only. It now appears that, because of delays in the construction of its boat, applicant will be unable to commence operations until approximately May 30, 1938, and has requested an extension of time to that date in which to commence operations.

It appearing that this request is reasonable and should be granted,

IT IS ORDERED that Decision No. 29507, as amended by Decision No. 29830, is reaffirmed and that the time within which service may be commenced is extended to June 1, 1938, provided that on or before April 1, 1938, applicant shall file with the Commission a verified statement showing the status of construction or acquisition of a vessel or vessels to be used in rendering such service, together with such other facts as shall show that applicant will be prepared to establish service not later than June 1, 1938. Should such verified statement not be filed on or before April 1, 1938, or should such statement

fail to show applicant's ability to commence service on June 1, 1938, the authority granted shall lapse and become void as of April 1, 1938.

This supplemental order shall be effective immediately.
