O P I N I O N

In this application Valley and Coast Transit Company, a corporation, requests authority to discontinue the transportation of passengers between San Luis Obispo and San Simeon and intermediate points via Morro, Cayucos, and Cambria and to abandon its operating right therefor.

As justification for the authority sought, applicant alleges that there no longer exists any public need for such service inasmuch as Pacific Greyhound Lines, by Decision No. 29784, dated May 24, 1937 was authorized to operate, in part, between Monterey and San Luis Obispo and intermediate points via San Simeon and Cambria, said operation being restricted to the transportation of passengers and their baggage and newspapers.

A hearing does not seem to be necessary and the authority sought appears to be in the public interest. The application will be granted.

O R D E R

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Valley and Coast Transit Company is hereby authorized to discontinue and abandon the automotive

transportation of passengers between San Luis Obispo and San Simeon and intermediate points via Morro, Cayucos and Cambria, heretofore authorized by Decision No. 19262, dated January 18, 1928, on Application No. 14339, subject to the following conditions:

1. Applicant shall within thirty (30) days from the date hereof and on not less than ten (10) days' notice to the Commission and the public, cancel its Local Passenger Tariff No. 1-A, C.R.C. No. 2 effective July 9, 1928 and Supplement No. 1 thereto, effective August 27, 1930.
2. Applicant shall within thirty (30) days from the date hereof and on not less than ten (10) days' notice to the Commission and the public, cancel its passenger time schedule covering service between the points herein involved.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty (20) days from the date hereof.
