## FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Decision No. 29757 (May 10, 1937) authorized The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company to dispense with the services of a caretaker at the stations of Goffs, Bagdad and Newberry and in lieu thereof establish company telephones at said stations. Applicant has requested that it be relieved of maintaining telephones. It appears that the request with respect to Goffs and Bagdad is reasonable. At Newberry, however, it appears that either a caretaker or a telephone should be maintained.

Good Cause Appearing, it is ordered that Condition (3) of Decision No. 29757 be amended to read as follows:

(3) Provision shall be made by applicant for the use by prospective patrons, for railroad business, of a company telephone, which shall be maintained at Newberry station under lock, the key to which shall likewise be placed in the hands of a responsible party at or near said station.

In all other respects Decision No. 29757 shall remain in force. Dated, San Francisco, California, August 28, 1937.
