BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct one spur track at grade across Sonora Street in Stockton, San Joaquin County, at the location described in the application and identified as a portion of Crossing No. D-90.65-C. Applicant shall bear entire expense of construction and maintenance. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72, without super-elevation, and of a width to conform to that portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with roadway, and with grades of approach not exceeding six (6) per cent. Protection shall be by existing Standard No. 1 crossing sign (G. O. No. 75-A).

Within thirty (30) days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one (1) year (unless time be extended), or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
