ORDER

The Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct a spur track at grade across Chino Avenue and Fifteenth Street, and across Schaefer Street in the City of Chino, San Bernardino County, at the locations described in the application.

The crossing at Chino Avenue and Fifteenth Street shall be identified as Crossing No. BAB-520.71-C, and the crossing of Schaefer Street shall be identified as BAB-521.22-C.

Authorization is also granted to cross Fourteenth Street and two alleys in Block 25, all of which are paper streets and not open to travel.

Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expenses. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to those portions of the streets now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding 2%. Protection at each of the crossings shall be by two (2) Standard No. 1 crossing signs (G. O. 75-A).

Within thirty (30) days after completion, pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one (1) year (unless it be extended) or if above conditions are not complied with.

Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
