O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct one spur track at grade across State Line Road, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. CFA-533.4, and at grade across Tule Lake Feeder Road, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. CFA-533.3-C. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72, without superelevation and of widths to conform to the portions of the roads now graded, with tops of the rails flush with roadway, and with grades of approach not exceeding four per cent. Protection at each crossing shall be by one Standard No. 1 crossing sign (G.O. 75-A).

Within thirty days after completion, pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year (unless time be extended), or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
