It appears from the above application that no passenger or less-than-carload freight business has been transacted at applicant's station of Meadowsweet, in the County of Marin, for more than one year and that its continued maintenance is only necessary for the handling of carload shipments.

Good Cause Appearing, Northwestern Pacific Railroad Company is authorized to change its Class "C" non-agency station of Meadowsweet, in the County of Marin, to a Class "B" station; remove its station building at said station; and cancel all tariffs applying to said station, except tariffs applying to carload business.

Within thirty (30) days after the abandonment, applicant shall so advise the Commission, in writing.

This authorization shall become null and void if not exercised within one year from the date hereof.

This Order shall become effective immediately.
