O R D E R

Pacific Gas and Electric Company, a corporation, having filed an application with the Railroad Commission of the State of California requesting approval of a certain agreement entered into by and between Pacific Gas and Electric Company, a corporation, and Fred Schleef, who is engaged in the business of mining, in words and figures as set forth in the copy of said agreement marked Exhibit "A" and attached to the application herein, said agreement providing, among other things, for the sale and delivery to said Fred Schleef, as an accommodation and without dedication of same to public use, of such quantities of excess water available in Pacific Gas and Electric Company's Boardman Canal not exceeding a flow of twenty-five (25) miner's inches⁽¹⁾ as said Fred Schleef shall request for mining purposes in certain terri-

(1) For the purpose of this agreement a miner's inch shall mean 1.5 cubic feet of water per minute.

tory located within the southwest quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 14, Township 11 North, Range 7 East, M.D.B. & M., in Placer County, California, said water to be paid for at the rate of sixteen cents (16¢) per miner's inch day⁽²⁾, and it appearing that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted, now, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Pacific Gas and Electric Company, a corporation, be and it is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement for the sale and delivery of excess water to Fred Schleef under substantially the same terms and conditions as are set forth in the form of agreement marked Exhibit "A" which is attached to the application herein and made a part hereof by reference.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Pacific Gas and Electric Company, a corporation, file with this Commission within thirty (30) days from the date of this Order two certified copies of said agreement as finally consummated.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.

(2) For the purpose of this agreement a miner's inch day shall mean one miner's inch as heretofore defined flowing for a period of twenty-four hours.
