It appears from the above application that insufficient passenger and freight business has been transacted at applicant's non-agency station of La Mirada for the twelve-month period ending April 30, 1937, to justify the maintenance of a carotakor at this location, as provided for in conditions (1) and (2) of Decision No. 25801, in Application No. 18743. California Farm Bureau Federation has signified, in writing, that it has no objection to the granting of this application.

Good Cause Appearing, The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company is authorized to dispense with the services of a part-time employee and caretaker at the station of La Mirada, County of Los Angeles, and to continue to operate said station of La Mirada as a non-agency station. Within thirty days after effecting the change herein authorized, applicant shall so notify the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended.

IT IS ORDERED that conditions (1) and (2) of Decision No. 25801, dated April 3, 1933, are of no further force and effect.
