O R D E R

It appears from the application that the volume of freight business transacted at applicant's station of Del Rosa for the year ending March 31, 1937, is insufficient to warrant the continued maintenance of a part-time employe, as provided for in conditions (2) and (3) of the Commission's Decision No. 25267, in application No. 18349. California Farm Bureau Federation has signified in writing that it has no objection to the granting of this application.

Good Cause Appearing, The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company is authorized to dispense with the services of a part-time employee at the station of Del Rosa, County of San Bernardino, and to continue the same as a non-agency station. Within thirty days after the discontinuance is authorized herein, applicant shall so notify the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year (unless time be extended).

IT IS ORDERED that conditions (2) and (3) of Decision No. 25267, dated October 17, 1932, are of no further force and effect.

This Order shall be effective immediately.
